The Southern Africa Solidarity Coalition would like to inform you of two forthcoming events.

On Saturday, April 17, there will be a teach-in and day of solidarity for the liberation struggle of the people of Zimbabwe (Rhodesia). There will be speakers representing the African National Council of Zimbabwe (North American Branch) and other organisations, and a series of workshops. The teach-in will take place at Harvard University Science Center, Oxford and Kirkland Streets, Cambridge, 9 am to 6 pm. It is sponsored by ANC, North American Branch, with African Students and Workers for African Liberation and Southern African Solidarity Coalition.

On the following Saturday, April 24, there will be a Conference of Solidarity with the Struggle of the Eritrean People, sponsored by Eritreans for Liberation in North America and other organisations. The afternoon program of workshops will run from 1 pm to 6 pm. The evening program (7 pm to 12 pm) will include speeches, slides, a film and cultural presentations. It will take place at Boston University, Hayden Auditorium.

Southern Africa Solidarity Coalition (SASC) is an outgrowth of the Angola Solidarity Coalition which formed at the beginning of this year. We would like to keep interested people informed on a continuing basis about activities of solidarity with African liberation and information about liberation struggles. We are now beginning to build up a mailing list. Please write us also if you would like to be involved in planning future activities.
