Mozambique: The Struggle for Survival (1987), 57 minutes

One of the best general documentaries about Mozambique. This film employs excellent file footage while providing historical background of Mozambique's colonial history and the struggle for independence.

Chain of Tears, Executive Producer Toni Strasberg, for Channel 4, London, approx. 1 hr.

Examines the effect of apartheid on South Africa's program of destabilization against its neighbors on the children of the Frontline States.

Riding Out the Storm, 30 minutes

This is an excellent and moving short film that looks at the war in Mozambique through the eyes of a number of Mozambicans.

Mozambique: Scene of a Crime, 1987 approx. 1 hr.

A comprehensive examination of the destruction wrought by the MNR bandits and the peoples' and government's efforts to build the country in the face of it.
