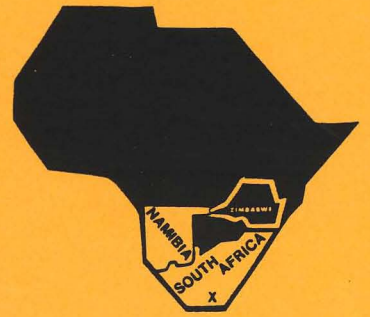


LAST GRAVE AT DIMBAZA
