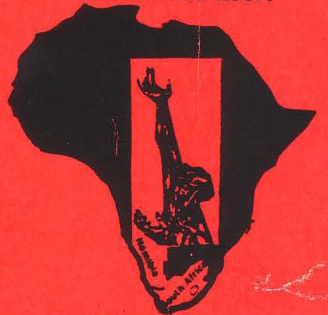
The Committee Against Racism and Apartheid on Campus

The MSU Board of Trustees divested its funds from South Africa in 1978, on the principle that an institution of higher learning should not invest in apartheid. The MSU Foundation, which comes under the jurisdiction of the Trustees, has retained its South African investments and adopted the Sullivan Principles. This policy is not in compliance with MSU divestiture action or the State of Michigan educational divestiture law.

The Coalition Against Racism and Apartheid on Campus, (CARAC) has written to the Trustees in protest but has received no response. CARAC sent a resource person to speak to the Foundation but nothing has yet been changed. ASMSU has publicly requested the Trustees to instruct the Foundation to divest. The Foundation spokesperson has stated there has been "No groundswell of protest."

Speakers from the Southern Africa Liberation Committee, (SALC) and CARAC, will address the Trustees at the 1:15 comment session. PLEASE COME JOIN THE GROUNDSWELL!
