WHAT IS AFRICAN LIBERATION DAY.....

"AFRICAN LIBERATION DAY" IS A DAY SET ASIDE BY THE NATIONS AND PEOPLES OF AFRICA TO CELEBRATE VICTORIES OF THE AFRICAN PEOPLE IN THEIR JUST STRUGGLE FOR LIBERATION AND SOCIAL PROGRESS. THROUGH BITTER BATTLES, OUR PEOPLE WON POLITICAL INDEPENDENCE AND PUT AN END TO DIRECT EUROPEAN COLONIALISM, EXCEPT IN SOUTHERN AFRICA(ZIMBAWE, AZANIA, AND NAMIBIA). THIS WAS A GREAT ACHIEVEMENT WHICH SIGNIFICANTLY CONTRIBUTED TO THE PROGRESS OF MANKIND.
