MINUTES 25 July 1988

18 July Rally: Jerry reported that about 75 supporters of such groups as SNAG, SAA & CAST showed up for the rally and that the music of the Anzanga Marimba Ensemble drew hundreds more. Jerry & Caryn printed and distributed two fliers and a post card drawing attention to political prisoners in South Africa. It was agreed that they should be reimbursed (approx\$35) for printing costs.

Postcard: Jerry will rework the wording and Jerry and Caryn will try to get it reprinted in time for the ATU picnic, 30 July. They will get the finished product to Shirley for distribution. This version will be sold for the cost of postage and printing and SLCAA will mail them after we have gleaned the names and addresses of the purchasers.

Strategy Meeting: The anti-apartheid community will meet at CAMP 27 July at 7:30 to discuss a unified strategy.

Educational Program: The subcommittee decided to focus on either the Shell boycott, Moses Mayekiso or Ron Dellums' Comprehensive Sanctions Bill. Information is being sought for a final decision at the 17 August meeting at Shirley's (1726-26th) at 8pm. Caryn

suggested that we all begin assembling information for the fact sheet.. She proposed that we go through our sources and highlight significant facts and then bring these highlighted sources to the 17 August meeting. She also volunteered the use of her word processor for producing the fact sheet.
