BACKGROUND OF THE

ILLINOIS LABOR NETWORK AGAINST APARTHEID

*Formed in late 1987, the Network was inspired largely by the solidarity of the strike of 350,000 mine workers in South Africa.

*Its purpose is to educate and activate local unions on behalf of South African unions and against apartheid.

*The Network has:

*sponsored educational programs, rallies and protest campaigns;

*hosted South African union and community leaders;

*worked for the release of jailed trade unionists;

*mobilized support for Comprehensive, Mandatory Economic Sanctions;

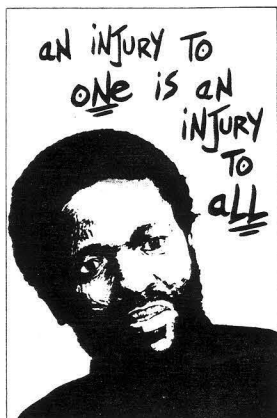
*targeted companies that have violated the rights of South African workers; and

*presented programs on South Africa to local affiliates.

*The Network is governed by a Steering Committee composed of more than two dozen representatives of local union affiliates in Illinois.

*It is funded by the direct and inkind contributions of local union affiliates.
