The South African Freedom Charter was unanimously adopted by the *The Congress of the People* held in Kiptown on June 26, 1985.

Nearly 3,000 observers and 2,888 delegates representing the African National Congress, the South African Indian Congress, the South African Colored Peoples' Organization and the Congress of Democrats (a white organization supporting the liberation movement) attended the Conference. The Freedom Charter represents the aspirations of all South Africans fighting for a free and just society. As a result of this historic gathering June 26 is recognized internationally as South Africa Freedom Day.
