TRANSKEI INDEPENDENCE

The racist regime of South Africa is currently engaged in a master deceit plan of testing its theory of Apartheid or Separate Development policy under the guise of granting independence to the Transkei Homeland in October 26, 1976. Under this phoney plan 13% of the land will be superimposed on the 16 million Blacks, while the 4 million Whites occupy the remaining 87% of the land.

The facist regime of South Africa has set a vast campaign to promote international recognition of the area, making every effort to have the Transkei Homeland admitted to the United Nations. Vorster, the self-styled racist war-mongering Prime Minister of South Africa hopes that through such a window dressing Western Nations will explicitly or implicitly recognize the territory and consequently bring foreign investments in the area.

There is no doubt that if diplomatic recognition of the Transkei takes place, it will be the biggest victory yet for the white nazi-style regime.

In economic terms, independence will mean acceptance of the existence of permanent colonies of migrant Black labor, whose people will be exploited by the demands of the white economy on its terms alone.

In political terms, international acceptance of the Transkei territory will mean acceptance of the claim that Blacks can have self-determination under a colony with no control of natural resources or National Army within the physical confines of the present South African State. The truth of the matter is that recognition of the independence of the Transkei will mean acceptance of the theory and practice of apartheid. Apartheid offers false hopes to the oppressed Blacks, while it gains victory and optimism for the repressive racist regime. It is against such a despicable background that the United Nations, Organization of African Unity, World Council of Churches, and other international bodies have condemned South Africa's white government for its racist regime, and rejected the independence of the Transkei. Join us on the 23rd and 25th of October 1976 in demonstration against Apartheid and its Brain-Child the independence of the Transkei.

Imperialism and racism must be ended in Southern Africa. Long live the African National Liberation Struggles for Self-determination, Land, Independence, and Solidarity with African peoples Liberation Struggles in Southern Africa.
