I'm so pleased to inform you that Numonde Ngubo, a South African mine worker in exile now on the staff of the United Mine Workers in Washington, D.C., will be our keynote speaker.

Our next Steering Committee meeting will be on Wednesday, June 22 at 8:30 a.m. at ACTWU, 333 S. Ashland.

Congressman Dellums office informed us yesterday that Cong. Terry Bruce, Frank Annunzio and Martin Russo are now committed to voting YES on H.R.1580 for Comprehensive Sanctions against South Africa.

There are now 5 undecided votes in the Illinois delegation: Cong. Richard Durbin, John Porter, Jack Davis, Dan Rostenkowski, and William Lipinski, and of course Sen. Dixon in the Senate. Please contact Sen. Dixon, as well as Sen. Lugar (Indiana), and these Congressmen to ask their full support of S.556/H.R.1580, with no weakening amendments. The House vote will be around June 20.

Thank you to AFT Local 4100 and others for your help on this.
