Dear CFSA member,


Our last meeting of CFSA was small, both in participation and agenda. The most immediate action item was a mid-December trip to Washington by SWAPO member Selma Ashipala. This trip has been cancelled, because Ms. Ashipala was called back to Angola unexpectedly.

Bill Minter and Lynne Barbee reported on their investigations into the possibility of producing a poster-size map of southern Africa that would depict South African regional aggression. Jim True, a graphic artist, describes it as a major project, which could cost as much as \$15,000 for production alone (for 5000 copies). CFSA would clearly have to find another organization to work with us on this.

Since we were a small group, we did not proceed with our discussion of proposals for fundraising and educational outreach work. So please refer to Roger Walke's first-rate letter of November 14 to prepare for our next meeting, which will be on Monday, December 5 at 7:30 at 8314 Carye Lane, Aptl 231 in Silver Spring (call 585-3265 for directions).
