- D6 MAU MAU FROM WITHIN: AUTOBIOGRAPHY AND ANALYSIS OF KENYA'S PEASANT REVOLT (*Monthly Review*, 1966), by Don Barnett and Karari Njama. What was the "Mau Mau" war against colonial rule in Kenya? Karari Njama, one of the few educated persons to join the guerrillas in the Aberdare forest, gives a lucid description of the day-to-day life and practice, the hopes, aspirations and problems of Kenya's peasant guerrillas. Alongside Njama's autobiography, Don Barnett provides a marxist analysis of the movement, its class basis, causes, achievements and failures. 512 pages, paperback. [no discounts] \$3.50
- D7 THE REVOLUTION IN ANGOLA: MPLA, LIFE HISTORIES AND DOCUMENTS (Bobbs-Merrill, 1972), by LSM Information Center Director Don Barnett and photographer Roy Harvey. Through these documents and life histories of MPLA militants we learn the answers to some basic questions: Who are the Angolan people, the guerrillas, the cadres and the leadership of the MPLA?
