The Southern Africa Committee (SAC) is a research and educational group seeking to promote a more informed concern about Western penetration of the African sub-continent, with particular emphasis on the role played by the United States. It studies conditions in Southern Africa as well as the impact of U.S. governmental and economic policies in the area, and prepares resource materials for the use of interested individuals and organizations.

SAC's specific commitment is to support the liberation struggles of the peoples of Southern Africa while joining in the wider effort to end human exploitation everywhere.

SAC in New York has for nine years published Southern Africa, a monthly journal. SAC in North Carolina produces AFRICA NEWS twice weekly for broadcasters. Also in the Durham office is the Committee's research center where more than 50 periodicals, as well as reference books and statistical publications, are used to prepare documents, pamphlets, and media presentations.
