Re: Preparatory work for possible Mozambique/
South Africa negotiations.

1. A leading anti-apartheid black minister pointed out to me recently that it was imperative that the Mozambique support forces move now to frame the national discussion that may arise around South Africa-Mozambique talks. The main concern is that we project the debate in such a way that the American people better understand the binding situation in which Mozambique is rather than hundreds of articles heralding South Africa's great benevolence.
2. Our friends in New York have begun a massive writing offensive (letters, articles, press releases, leaflets for events). Is it possible that others may do the same so that we keep control of the overall game. Of course, we can't govern all that the monopoly media will do. But we can "ride point," so to speak, as to a general direction, especially if we start information offensives right away.
