In response to requests from groups in South Africa, the World Council of Churches, Free South Africa Movement, AFL-CIO, NAACP, and United Mine Workers have all targeted Royal Dutch/Shell (Shell Oil's parent company) because it supplies essential fuel to the apartheid system.

Apartheid not only enslaves South Africans. It also affects Americans.

Taking advantage of the apartheid system's slave labor conditions, hundreds of the world's largest corporations:

- **Invest in South Africa** instead of investing in job-producing operations in the U.S.

- **Export products from South Africa** to the U.S. and other countries that normally buy from the U.S.

Lower labor standards in countries like South Africa help create a climate for employers to demand a lower standard of living for Americans as well.

Citizen groups have targeted Royal Dutch/Shell because it supplies fuel to the apartheid economy and to the South African military and police who enforce the apartheid slave labor system.

South Africa does not have its own oil supplies. **Without companies like Royal Dutch/Shell, apartheid could not survive.**

Royal Dutch/Shell produces and sells products in the names of more than 300 subsidiaries, including Shell Oil Co. in the U.S and Shell South Africa. The products of all subsidiaries are targets of the boycott campaign.
