A MASS MEETING OF ALL FACULTY, STUDENTS AND STAFF HAS BEEN CALLED AT U.C.L.A. IN MANDELA CITY/SCHOENBERG QUAD TO DISCUSS THE FOLLOWING PROPOSAL AND ALL OTHER IDEAS WHOSE GOAL IS SOLIDARITY WITH POLITICAL PRISONERS IN SOUTH AFRICA ON FRIDAY OCTOBER 11, 1985.

OCTOBER 11th --- BOYCOTT CLASSES!

TWO MONTHS OF APARTHEID'S "STATE OF EMERGENCY" WITH MASS ARRESTS, TORTURE AND MURDERS HAVE FAILED TO CRUSH THE STRUGGLE OF THE AZANIAN/SOUTH AFRICAN PEOPLE. FROM THE SHANTYTOWNS TO THE UNIVERSITIES TO THE HIGHSCHOOLS, THE UPRISINGS CONTINUE, INSPIRING THE WORLD.

THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT CONTINUES TO SHOW ITSELF THE CHIEF SUPPORTER AND PROFITEER OF APARTHEID. NOW, IN THE FACE OF WORLD OUTRAGE IT OFFERS UP MEANINGLESS SANCTIONS AND STILL MORE EMPTY WORDS.

OCTOBER 11, 1985 IS AN INTERNATIONAL DAY OF SOLIDARITY WITH POLITICAL PRISONERS IN SOUTH AFRICA. IN THE SPIRIT OF THE CONTINUING STUDENT BOYCOTTS IN SOUTH AFRICA, WE AT U.C. SAN DIEGO, U.C.L.A. AND U.C. BERKELEY ARE ORGANIZING AN ACTIVE BOYCOTT OF CLASSES. WE ENCOURAGE STUDENTS ON OTHER CAMPUSES

THROUGHOUT THE UNITED STATES TO CONSIDER A BOYCOTT
AND/OR OTHER CREATIVE ACTIONS.

A CALL FOR A STATEWIDE STUDENT CONFERENCE

GIVEN THAT,

- 1-THE OVERTHROW OF THE APARTHEID REGIME IN SOUTH AFRICA WILL BE OF GREAT BENEFIT TO HUMANITY AS A WHOLE AND TO THE OPPRESSED EVERYWHERE AND ALSO BE A BLOW TO THE IMPERIALIST SYSTEM.
- 2-THE OVERTHROW OF THE APARTHEIDREGIME WILL HELP ADVANCE THE STRUGGLE AGAINST FORMS OF APARTHEID WITHIN THE UNITED STATES, AGAINST ALL KINDS OF DISCRIMINATION, RACIAL OPPRESSION AND PERSECUTION.
- 3-THE MOUNTING AND COURAGEOUS STRUGGLE OF THE BLACK SOUTH AFRICAN MASSES HAS INSPIRED THE OPPRESSED AND PROGRESSIVE TO TAKE UPON THE TASK OF BUILDING SOLIDARITY WITH THAT STRUGGLE.
- 4-THE MOST DYNAMIC SECTOR OF THIS MOVEMENT OF SOLIDARITY IS COMPOSED OF STUDENTS FROM COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES ACROSS THE COUNTRY.

5-THE STUDENT SECTOR OF THE MOVEMENT SHOULD PLAY THE ROLE OF A CATALYST CAPABLE OF TURNING THE MOBILIZATIONS AGAINST APARTHEID INTO A FORCE THAT CAN LEAD TO THE FORMATION OF AN ORGANIZED MOVEMENT WITH A NATIONWIDE SCOPE, THAT INCLUDES THE OPPRESSED AND WORKING PEOPLE OF THIS COUNTRY THAT WOULD HELP THE BLACK MASSES IN SOUTH AFRICA BRING WHITE RULE TO ITS KNEES.

6-THE ADMINISTRATIONS AND THE BOSSES OF THE UNIVERSITIES ARE IN COMPLICITY WITH THE APARTHEID REGIME FOR THE PROFITS THEY DERIVE FROM IT AND ARE THEREFORE A BARRIER TO ACHIEVING DIVESTMENT.

WE RESOLVE THAT,

A-THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA REGENTS MEETING AT THE U.C. SAN FRANCISCO EXTENSION CENTER ON OCTOBER 16th AND 17th BE CLOSED DOWN BECAUSE THEY WILL NOT BE ADDRESSING THOSE ISSUES THAT ARE CRUCIAL TO STUDENTS.

B-A STATEWIDE CONFERENCE OF ALL GROUPS, ORGANIZATIONS OF STUDENTS AS WELL AS INDIVIDUALS FROM ALL CAMPUSES ALL OVER CALIFORNIA BE CONVENED AT THE U.C. BERKELEY CAMPUS ON SATURDAY, OCTOBER 18, 1985.

C-THIS CONFERENCE WILL HAVE AS ITS PURPOSE THE DISCUSSION AND ELABORATION OF A STRATEGY TO ADVANCE THE ANTI-APARTHEID AND DIVESTMENT MOVEMENT.

D-THIS CONFERENCE WOULD SEEK THE WAY TO LINK THE STRUGGLE AGAINST APARTHEID IN SOUTH AFRICA TO THE STRUGGLE AGAINST DISCRIMINATION AND RACISM (APARTHEID) IN THE UNITED STATES.

E-THIS CONFERENCE WILL SEEK WAYS TO LINK THE SOLIDARITY MOVEMENTS WITH STRUGGLES IN CENTRAL AMERICA, THE MIDDLE EAST, SOUTH EAST ASIA AND OTHER PARTS OF THE WORLD.

F-THIS CONFERENCE WILL SEEK WAYS TO COMBAT THE FACT THAT THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA IS THE LEADING U.S. PARTICIPANT IN THE RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT THAT FURTHERS THE ARMS RACE; THIS DEVELOPMENT CONCENTRATES ON SUCH THINGS AS STAR WARS, ETHNIC DISEASES AS WELL AS NUCLEAR BOMBS AND WEAPONS.

G-THIS CONFERENCE SHOULD DISCUSS THE NEED TO BUILD A TRULY MASSIVE AND ORGANIZED STUDENT MOVEMENT THAT CAN LEAD THE FIGHT FOR UNIVERSITIES AND SCHOOLS GOVERNED BY COUNCILS OF STUDENTS, FACULTY AND STAFF AND NOT BANKERS AND CORPORATE AND BUSINESS LEADERS.

H-THIS CONFERENCE BE THE FIRST STEP TOWARD A NATIONAL STUDENT CONFERENCE OF THE STUDENT MOVEMENT TO DISCUSS SIMILAR ISSUES NATIONWIDE.

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED ASK FOR YOUR SUPPORT IN THIS ENDEAVOR.
